Dear City of Minden Resident,

Starting January 9, 2026, Republic Services' Residential trucks will only be collecting waste inside Company provided 96-gallon carts. 2 carts per residence maximum. Cart service will continue to be on Fridays.

**On-call bulk collection:** Also beginning on January 9, 2026, Resident bulk collection will be moving to an on-call service. Residents will be able to schedule the following for collection to be collected within a 7-day period:

- Up to ten (10) bags of yard waste
- Large piles of limbs. Piles can be no larger than a 6 ft high, 6 ft wide and 6 ft long and 6 inches in diameter.
- One (1) large household item such as couch, recliner, bed mattress etc.
- No home cleanouts, homeowner/landlord responsible for disposal.

**Webster Parish Landfill Access:** Starting January 2, 2026, City of Minden Residents will be allowed to utilize the Webster Parish Landfill at no charge for residential waste. No charge access will be allowed one time per week per home; providing resident has a utility bill that states sanitation fee from address and Identification with the same family name as stated on utility bill. No commercial construction or lawn/tree care companies. Residents will be allowed to bring the equivalent of the above-mentioned service.

# Proper Cart Placement Is the Key to Automated Service



- Have the cart at the curb by 6 a.m. on your collection day.
- Place the cart at least 5 feet from any object – like a car, tree, pole, fire hydrant, mailbox, electrical box, or cable box – so the automated arm can reach your cart.
- Please maintain this same distance of 5 feet between and waste carts.
- Don't lean anything against the cart.
- Don't place your cart under a tree.
- Place carts 1 foot from the curb or edge of the street.
- Place the cart with the arrows on the lid pointing toward the street and the handle toward your house.
- Remember to close the lid of the cart.
- Please don't allow children to play in or around the carts. Our trucks use mechanical arms to pick up the recycling and waste carts.
