

Dear City of Minden Resident,

Did you know Republic Services now offers several ways to manage your trash service and request additional help?

Residential trash is collected each Friday. All household trash must be placed inside a Republic Services-provided 96-gallon cart. Each residence may have up to two carts.

Bulk collection is available by request. Once scheduled, eligible items will be collected within seven days. Residents may request collection of:

- Up to 10 bags of yard waste
- One pile of limbs no larger than 6 feet high, 6 feet wide and 6 feet long, with limbs no more than 6 inches in diameter
- One large household item, such as a couch, recliner or mattress

Home cleanouts are not included. Property owners and landlords are responsible for disposing of waste from home cleanouts.

Residents may also take eligible residential waste to the Webster Parish Landfill at 493 Landfill Road once per week at no charge. You must bring a City of Minden utility bill showing a sanitation fee and identification with the same family name listed on the bill. This service is not available to commercial construction, lawn care or tree-service companies.

The landfill will accept:

- Up to 10 bags of household waste
- Up to 10 bags of yard waste
- One qualifying pile of limbs
- One large household item

Proper Cart Placement Is the Key to Automated Service



- Have the cart at the curb by 6 a.m. on your collection day.
- Place the cart at least 5 feet from any object – like a car, tree, pole, fire hydrant, mailbox, electrical box, or cable box – so the automated arm can reach your cart.
- Please maintain this same distance of 5 feet between and waste carts.
- Don't lean anything against the cart.
- Don't place your cart under a tree.
- Place carts 1 foot from the curb or edge of the street.
- Place the cart with the arrows on the lid pointing toward the street and the handle toward your house.
- Remember to close the lid of the cart.
- Please don't allow children to play in or around the carts. Our trucks use mechanical arms to pick up the recycling and waste carts.
